Register yourself at least 1 hour before your performance, so ensure timely entrance at the start.

By registration you will receive:

- Wrist tickets for competitors, for accompaniment of groups up to 2 tickets / group, for accompaniment of small formations, in the number of 1 ticket / club
- meal vouchers for ordered and paid lunches
- the original invoice
- Information about the dressing rooms
- Annual World Championship Majorettes Sports with starting lists
- alternatively any further information

Wrist tickets (entrance tickets) strengthens the chief to each competitor on her wrist (wrist ticket must not be removable) before entering the sports hall. Entrance to the hall is only with a wrist ticket, the ticket is valid for all 4 days. In the event of a loss, a replacement ticket is not issued.

IV. Admission fee

- in advance of CZK 125/5 EUR, here is the link <http://ifms-majorettes.com/tickets/>, one-day entrance fee (door price) CZK 250/10 EUR
- Entrance fee not reimbursed for competitor majorettes and accompaniment, if their wrist ticket is shown at the entrance
- Entrance fee, including a reservation do not cover children up to 6 years, and children with health disabilities, adult health disabilities card holders 125 CZK (50%)
- Tickets for tourist accompaniment and other general public are on sale at the ticket office at the entrance to the hall, **they also serve as a reservation and are marked with the grandstand letter, number of row and seat number**
- Ban of putting things and top parts on free seats
- Competitors may watch the programme from the reserved part of the grandstand, follow the instructions of the organizers
- Ban of using the stairs to sit on for the whole hall (hall security regulation)





At the entrance for the public can be bought an annual World Championship Majorettes Sport 2 EUR / CZK 50, in the annual there are published the start lists

V. Spaces

Non-competitive space for competitors

- designated dressing rooms with accessories
- **hall B determined for warm-up**
- **ban on body and shoes leaning against the wall, threatening to dirt and scuff**

Into non-competitive space for participants of the contest are not allowed the entrance to the tourist accompaniment and other public!

Spaces for tourist accompaniment and other public (viewers)

- seats in the grandstand on reservations and access roads to the grand stand from the main entrance

Spaces for VIP

- designated seats on the grandstand
- designated room for VIPs

Spaces for judges

- designated room for judges
- stands at the competition area

VI. Competition area in hall A

For stage competition sets 12 m x 12 m + protection zone, standardized surface.

For marching parade of 25m x 7 m + boarding area and the safeguard zone, standardized surface.

The entrance of the contestants at the competition area (start) follows the guidance of a designated person to control the entrances. This person can accompany them up to the starting line; this line is not allowed for accompaniment of other person including chiefs, assistants, coaches

VII. Spatial tests

To warm up for the duration of the competition the sports hall B is available

Admission to the competition area for spatial tests in hall A

- 07:30 h - 8:30 h
- only for entrance and exit
- It is not allowed to practice or demonstration of competition sets or parts thereof
- It is not permitted to audience and to tourist accompaniment

VIII. Briefing

Briefing each competition day at 08:30 h, as appropriate also before the afternoon competition block, always after announcement by announcer, at the announcer stand

IX. Ceremonies

Initiation (each day of competition)

- entrance of chiefs, VIP, judges after announcer announcement, dress code social clothing
- Shoes without needle, metal and thin heels, preferably sport ones
- exit after the announcement by the announcer, following the instruction of the person managing the entrance

Results announcement

- to announcement will be prepared all competitors of appropriate disciplines (group, solo, duo-trio, mini)
- entrance for the announcement on the area after the announcement by announcer, instructed by a person to manage entrances
- participants are entering with marching step in line, stopping the step only on the announcer's instruction (stop the state, once, two) and turning face to the area with the winner stages
- groups entering accompanied by chief, (till 2 person), for accompaniment dress code social clothing or costume, the uniform of their group, shoes without needle, metal and thin heels
- the use of state flags is based on the principles of state symbols (only clean flags, blank, not otherwise damaged)
- Announcement to the 6th place,
- 7th till the last place will be awarded by the diplomas after announcing the results at the table with medals and cups, later in the registration room
- 1st place, may be the anthem for the winner with the national flag, for the duration of the anthem, the participants of the competition stand (without movements)
- leaving the area after the announcer announcement



X. Start and results lists

XI. Medical service
