Notice

Prohibition of food delivery and consumption in hall A, in hall B, grandstands and changing rooms. Drinks in hall A, in the grandstands and changing rooms and in hall B only in closed containers - plastic bottles, thermoses, see Operating Rules of the sports hall.

III. Registration in the sports hall and start fee

Register yourself at least 1 hour before your performance, so ensure timely entrance at the start.

By registration you receive:

- wrist tickets for competitors, for groups accompaniment as many as 2 entrance tickets/ group, for small formation accompaniment in number 1 entrance ticket/ club
- information about changing rooms
- possibly other current information

Wrist straps (tickets) will be fastened by the chief to each competitor's wrist tightly (the bracelet must not be loose), before entering the sports hall. Entrance to the hall is only with a wrist ticket, the ticket is valid on all competition days. In case of loss, a replacement ticket is not issued.

Start fee

The start fee is paid after the deadline for registration according to the number of formations based on the regulation – invoice in the deadline until the start of the competition in the amount of

- group 3000 CZK/120 €
- mini formation 1 500 CZK/60 €
- sólo, duo-trio 1000 CZK/40 €

IV. Entrance fee

- one-day entrance fee on the spot 200 CZK/8 EUR,
- Entrance fee is not paid for majorettes and accompaniment, if they prove themselves at the entrance with a wrist ticket
- Entrance fee, including the seat ticket, is not paid by children under 6 years of age and children holders of disabilities, adult holders of disabilities 100 CZK



- Entrance tickets for tourist accompaniment and the general public are for sale at the box office at the entrance to the hall, **they also serve as seat tickets and are marked with the letter of the grandstand, the row number and the number of seat**
- It is not allowed to place things and uppers on free seats
- the competitors have a reserved part of the grandstand for watching the program, follow the instructions of the organizers
- Prohibition of sitting on the stairs in the whole hall (safety regulations and operating rules of the hall)

V. Spaces

Non-competitive spaces for competitors

- marked changing rooms with accessories
- **prohibition of leaning on the walls of the body and shoes, there is a risk of dirt and hoeing**

Tourist accompaniment and the public are not allowed to enter the non-competition areas for the participants of the competition!

Spaces for tourist escorts and other public (spectators)

- grandstand seats for seat tickets and access roads to grandstands from the main entrance

VIP spaces

- marked seat tickets on the grandstand
- marked room for VIP

Spaces for referees

- marked room for referees
- stands at the competition area

VI. Competition area in hall A

For podium sets 12 m x 12 m + protection zone, standardized surface.

For marching parade 25 m x 7 m + boarding area and protection zone, standardized surface.

The entry of competitors to the competition area (start) is governed by the instructions of the designated person to control the entry. This person can accompany them to the starting line; escorting another person, including leaders, assistants, coaches, is not allowed to this line

VII. Spatial tests

Entrance to the competition area for spatial tests in hall A

- from 08:30 to 09:30
- for boarding and departure only
- training or demonstration of sets or their parts is not allowed
- is not allowed to spectators and tourist accompaniment

VIII. Breafink

Breafink every competition day at 09:30 h, if necessary before the afternoon competition block, always after the announcement by the announcer, at the announcer's station

IX. Ceremonies

Opening (every competition day)

- boarding of chiefs, VIPs, judges after announcement by the announcer, dress code formal dress
- footwear without stilettos, metal and narrow heels, preferably sports shoes
- departure after the announcement by the announcer, at the instruction of the person for the management of boardings

Results announcement

- all competitors of the relevant discipline (groups, solo, duo-trio, mini) will be prepared for the announcement
- boarding for the announcement on the area after the announcement by the announcer, at the instruction of the person for the management of boarding,
- participants take the marching step in a crowd, end the marching step only at the instruction of the announcer to stop and turn to face the tribune
- groups start accompanied by a chief (up to 2 people), for accompanying a dress code formal dress or costume, uniform of their group, shoes without stilettos, metal and narrow heels)





- when using national flags, the principles of national symbols are observed (only flags that are clean, unscrubbed or otherwise damaged)
- announcement to the 6th place,
- for the 7th place to the last place, the diplomas are issued after the announcement of the results at the place with medals and cups, later in the registration room
- 1st place, the anthem can be for the winner with the national flag, for the duration of the anthem the participants stand (no moves)
- leaving the area after the announcement by the announcer

X. Starting and result lists

Report changes to the starting lists at the registration or announcer or directly to the commissioner for processing the results

Starting lists are published at www.ifms-majorettes.com,

- in the WCH yearbook
- in the lobby (at the entrance for spectators)

XI. Medical service

- in room for doctors
- in hall in the area close to grandstand for the VIP

XII. Drinking regime

- for drinking regime of his wards is responsible the chief
- drinking water is in the water main of the sports hall

XIII. Meals and accommodation

- services according the instructions on www.ifms-majorettes.com,

XIV. Taking pictures and making videorecordings

Taking photos and videos only for accredited photographers, application for accreditation at e-mail:

vice.president@ifms-majorettes.com, no later than 2 days before the start of the competition or at accreditation

- the general public only from the spectator areas
- You cannot take photos or record videos using a tripod from the viewer area
- the use of a tripod reduces the view of the spectators and the spectators then demand a refund of the entrance fee; the organizer can demand this from photographers with a tripod
