Veliko Tarnovo is a city of many sights and it is one of the most popular tourist centres in Bulgaria. SPORT HALL VASIL LEVSKI



The reason for its construction is the celebration of the 800-year anniversary of the Asenevtsi uprising. The idea developed from the sports hall of the "Vasil Levski" National Military University.

- from 618 to 1000 seats formed in four mobile sectors;
